Mr. Ichiro Fujisaki entered the Foreign Ministry in 1969, Served in Jakarta, Paris and London. He assumed a number of key responsibilities in Japanese diplomacy, including the posts of Director-General for North American Affairs, Deputy Foreign Minister, Ambassador of Japan to the UN and WTO in Geneva and Ambassador of Japan to the United States. He had been a career diplomat over 40 years.
